# Fees & Fee Waiver Procedures

- At the beginning of each school year the parent will receive a packet containing a Free/Reduced Meals Application and a Fee Waiver Application. **\*\* Both Applications must be filled out in order to be considered for free or reduced meals and fees \*\***
- Included in the packet are instructions on how to fill out the forms, income eligibility guidelines, the Hawk-i/Medicaid Information form, the Free/Reduced Meals Application and the Fee Waiver Application. **Each school year the parent will need to fill out a new application.**
- The individual schools may take the parents' completed paperwork, make copies for their records, and send the originals to BAC\*. The parent may also send their paperwork directly to BAC\*. After the school secretaries receive verification from BAC\* Food Service that the student(s) qualify as free/reduced or denied, they may send a notice to the parent of the amount they owe. Please do not collect fees at the time of registration if the parents are planning on filling out this paperwork.
- Reduced fees are prorated at 60% and if a parent has overpaid, school secretaries must process a refund voucher and send it to BAC\* so that Accounting can issue the parent a refund check.
- If the family income or household number changes at any time during the school year, the parent must fill out new Free/Reduced Meals and Fee Waiver Applications and BAC\* must be notified. If their status changes, the amount they will owe or be refunded will be prorated for that quarter.
- If there are any changes during the first quarter, the amount will be prorated or refunded for 3 quarters. If changes occur during the second quarter amounts will be prorated by 1/2 and if change occurs during the third quarter of the school year amounts will be prorated by one quarter. This proration rule applies for textbook and transportation fees.
- BAC\* will have on file all of the paperwork that each parent fills out. Food Service will notify school secretaries of any status changes as they occur. On the first of every month Accounting will send out a report letting secretaries know of the students approved for free or reduced meals and fees, and status changes that have occurred. This report can be kept to answer any questions that a parent might have about his/her current status. This report will also let secretaries know if the parent has filled out the Fee Waiver Application. If the parent has not filled out the Fee Waiver Application, their fees are not free or reduced until they turn in this paperwork. Secretaries may send the Fee Waiver Application to the parent to remind them.
- Optional fees are not subject to fee waivers.
- The 30 day grandfather clause that allows parents time to turn in Free and Reduced applications only applies to Foodservice accounts.
