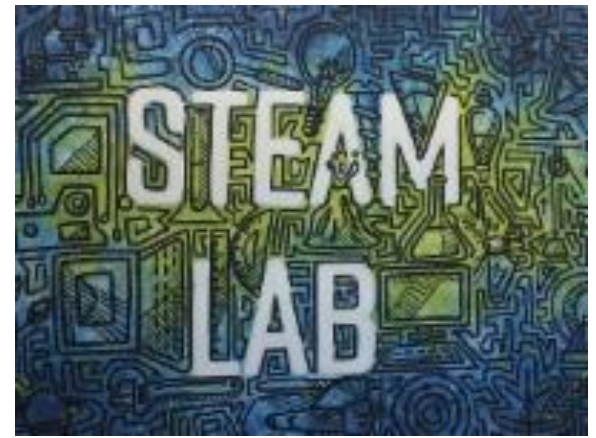
S601 –STEAM Hogwarts for Muggles
