TECHNOLOGY AND INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

The Board of Directors supports the use of innovative methods and the integration of technology in the delivery of the education program. The Board of Directors encourages school district personnel to investigate efficient and effective ways to incorporate instructional media, audiovisual materials, computers, and related technologies as a part of the curricular experiences offered to students.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent or designee to develop a plan for the use of technology in the curriculum and to evaluate it annually. The Superintendent shall report the results of the evaluation and make a recommendation to the Board of Directors regarding the use of technology in the curriculum.
