FREE OR REDUCED COST MEALS ELIGIBILITY

Students enrolled and attending school in the school district, who are unable to afford the cost or a portion of the cost of the school lunch, breakfast, and/or supplemental foods, will be provided the school food program services at no cost or at a reduced cost.

It shall be the responsibility of the food service official to determine if a student qualifies for free or reduced cost school nutrition services consistent with the guidelines established by the Federal Government for participation in the free and reduced price program.

Employees, students and others will be required to put appropriate funds on deposit for meals consumed.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent or designee to develop administrative regulations for implementing this policy.
