CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The Board of Directors believes a program of student activities is vital to the complete development of the student. Such activities offer opportunities to serve the institution, to assist in development of fellowship and social good will, to promote self-realization and personal growth, and encourage the learning of good citizenship qualities.

To assist in the administration of a student activities program, and to provide a framework of communication and review, a detailed structure of the activities program shall be developed by the administration and compiled in the parent-student handbook. The Board of Directors shall periodically review this program of activities and approve it as a part of the total curriculum of the district.

New co-curricular program offerings, deletions of co-curricular programs, major revisions to existing co-curricular programs or fundamental change or proposals to existing co-curricular programs must have the approval of the Board of Directors prior to implementation.
