EQUAL EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY

The Board of Directors will not discriminate in its educational activities on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, socio-economic status, disability, or marital status

The Board of Directors requires all persons, agencies, vendors, contractors and other persons and organizations doing business with or performing services for the school district to subscribe to all applicable federal and state laws, executive orders, rules and regulations pertaining to contract compliance.

The Board of Directors is committed to the policy that no otherwise qualified person will be excluded from educational activities on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, national origin, socio-economic status, disability, or marital status. Further, the Board of Directors affirms the right of all students and staff to be treated with respect and to be protected from intimidation, discrimination, physical harm and harassment.

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
