STUDENT GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING PROGRAM

The District shall provide a guidance and counseling program for the students enrolled delivered by a guidance counselor licensed by the State Department of Education and holding the qualifications required by the Board. The guidance counseling services will serve grades kindergarten through twelve. The program will assist students with their personal, educational, and career development. The program shall be designed to coordinate with the education program and to involve not only school district personnel but also students, parents, and community members.
