OPEN ENROLLMENT AS A RECEIVING DISTRICT REGULATION

GUIDELINE FOR ELEMENTARY STUDENTS ELIGIBLE TO OPEN ENROLL INTO THE BETTENDORF COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

Elementary students eligible to Open Enroll into the Bettendorf Community School District under the provisions of the Open Enrollment law are enrolling into the school district rather than an individual school building. The following administrative guidelines will be used for placement of elementary students eligible to Open Enroll into the Bettendorf Community School District:

- 1) For a child open enrolling into the Bettendorf Community School District as a new student. (Open enrollment applications must be filed by March 1 preceding the school year. Students entering kindergarten, September 1 to complete an application.)
 - A parent may request an elementary school for placement;
 - Placement will be made on availability of space;
 - Placement will be for the entire school year;
 - Once the student has been placed in a building, that school will be considered the "home school" placement of the child for the student's remaining elementary school career;
 - The child living in the attendance area shall have a priority claim on the available space.

- 2) For a child attending as a resident student, who moves into another Iowa district during the school year, to continue in the Bettendorf Community School District the open enrollment application must be filed by September 30 following the move.
 - The current placement of the child will be considered as the "home school" for the child for the balance of the student's elementary school career.
