STUDENT DISCIPLINE (MAINTENANCE OF ORDERLY CONDUCT)

Students are expected to conduct themselves well at all times, in keeping with their level of maturity. Respect for the authority vested in school employees, regard for public property, and consideration for the rights and welfare of other students should govern student behavior.

All employees of the District share the responsibility for seeing that student behavior meets standards of conduct that are conducive to learning. The aims of all school disciplinary rules and supervision are:

- 1) To encourage the student to take responsibility for his or her own actions; and
- 2) To gradually increase the student's self-discipline.
