

## Board Policy

Code No. 905.2

### TOBACCO FREE ENVIRONMENT

School district facilities and grounds, including school vehicles, shall be off limits for tobacco or nicotine use, including the use of look-a-likes where the original would include tobacco or nicotine. This requirement extends to students, employees and visitors. This policy applies at all times, including school-sponsored and nonschool-sponsored events. Persons failing to abide by this request shall be required to extinguish their smoking material, dispose of the tobacco, nicotine or other product, or leave the school district premises immediately. It shall be the responsibility of the administration to enforce this policy.
