LIVE BROADCAST OR VIDEOTAPING

Individuals may broadcast or record public school district events, including open board meetings, as long as it does not interfere with or disrupt the school district event and it does not create an undue burden in adapting the buildings and sites to accommodate the request.

It shall be within the discretion of the Superintendent or Principal to determine whether the request is unduly burdensome and whether the broadcast or record will interfere with or disrupt the school district event.

Recording of classroom activities will be allowed at the discretion of the building principal and classroom teacher, with notification to the Superintendent.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to develop administrative regulations outlining the procedures for making the request and the rules for operation if the request is granted.
