STATEMENT OF GUIDING PRINCIPLES

The Board of Directors recognizes the distinction between those activities which are appropriate to the Board of Directors as the legislative governing body of the District, and those administrative activities which are to be performed by the Superintendent and staff in the exercise of a delegated administrative authority. The function of the Board of Directors can be described as policy-making, appraisal, and evaluation.

The Board of Directors shall have the further duty of providing the financial means by which the educational program is conducted. They shall also ensure that the community be informed of the needs, purposes, values, and status of the schools.
