ADULT EDUCATION

The Board of Directors recognizes that the general objectives of post-high school and adult programs shall be the same as those of other levels of public education. These general objectives include preparing individuals for democratic citizenship, providing individuals with means for economic improvement and cultural development, and enriching the personal lives of the participating individuals.

The post-high school and adult education programs may be conducted in the facilities of the Bettendorf Community School District or other accredited public institutions under the auspices of accredited and recognized public colleges and universities.

Request for use of facilities must follow administrative rules and regulations for the use of school facilities.
