- 3. On activity trips, buses will be turned off if the temperature is above 30 degrees for the entire time of the event. Drivers may start bus 5-10 minutes prior to leaving from event.
- 4. If temperature is below 30 degrees and above 0 degrees, buses will be turned off for one hour, then restarted, put on fast idle for 15 minutes, then turned off again for one hour (off one hour, on 15 minutes through duration of event).
- 5. During subzero temperatures, buses will remain on fast idle for duration of event.

This regulation does not apply to special need buses due to use of lifts and other special need	S.
