MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Meetings of the Board of Directors are conducted for the purpose of carrying on the business of the schools. The meetings are usually held in public with a few exceptions or exemptions. Only Board members have the authority to make and second motions, and vote on issues before the Board. The Board of Directors may establish rules for its own governance and determine procedures that will be followed during Board meetings. Meetings may be closed to the public to allow the Board of Directors to discuss a specific topic from a narrow list of reasons and following the procedures defined by law.
