LICENSED EMPLOYEE JURY DUTY LEAVE

Any employee required to perform jury duty or to appear to testify (including proceedings where an employee's attendance is required by the Employer) during an Employee's working time shall be granted leave for such purpose and shall receive the difference in compensation between the employee's normal compensation and compensation received from such duty. Personal leave will be used for attendance in judicial proceedings initiated by the employee.
