

Board Policy

ADOPTION OF POLICY

All policy proposals shall be submitted to the Board of Directors, through the Superintendent and a Board Policy Review Committee, prior to a regular Board meeting. The adoption of new policies or amending or rescinding an existing policy is the exclusive responsibility of the Board of Directors. Any formal action to add, modify, or change existing Board policy will be by a majority vote of the membership of the Board during an open meeting. The proposed change must appear as an agenda item in normal situations for two readings before the Board of Directors may take official action to approve suggested change to Board policy (The second reading may be as a consent agenda item). The Board may, when necessary, waive the requirement for two separate readings.

If passed, the proposal will become effective upon the date of passage or at a time stated in the proposal, whichever occurs last.

In cases where action must be taken involving the operation of the school district, and where no guidelines have been established by Board policy, the Superintendent will have the authority to act. The action of the Superintendent will be subject to review by the Board of Directors at its next regular meeting.
