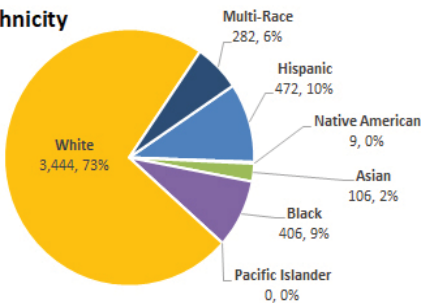

The Bettendorf Community School District is a flagship school district established in 1907.

The district provides a wide variety of educational programs for preschool through 12th grade students. Most students live within the district boundaries, nearly nine square miles within the City of Bettendorf, Iowa as well as a small section of Davenport, Iowa. There are seven schools in the district: five elementary schools, one middle school, and one high school with an alternative high school program (*shared with two other neighboring school districts*).
