Call to Order.

The Board of Directors of the Bettendorf Community School District, in the County of Scott, State of Iowa, met in open session according to Iowa law for a special Board meeting at the Administration Center, 3311 18th Street, Bettendorf, Iowa, on December 11, 2017. Discussion Items and Reports

**2018-19 At-Risk Budget.** At-Risk Coordinator Tammy Chelf presented information on the amount requested for modified supplemental amount of \$1,270,787 for the 2018-19 At-Risk/Dropout Budget. Guidance, school based mental health, outreach services, and academic interventions are some of the services paid for from the modified supplemental amount. These services help students who are considered At-Risk, or of potentially dropping out of school before they graduate

**Curriculum (ELP & Special Education) Presentations** (audio begins at 14m 20s). BMS Associate Principal Loreli Andedo and Student Services Director Kay Ingham presented information on the district's extended learning program (ELP) for gifted learners. They shared goals for developing the program throughout the district.

Kay Ingham, Grant Wood Principal John Cain, and Herbert Hoover Principal Karen Allison spoke to directors about the special education instructional service delivery plan. They shared the process used to develop the delivery system for eligible individuals, how the service is organized and provided to eligible individuals, and how the caseloads of special education teachers are determined and regularly monitored.

Motion by Director Lynch, seconded by Director Struck to approve a request for a Modified Supplemental amount of 1,270,787 for the 2018/19 At-Risk/Dropout Budget. Motion carried 5-0-1-1. Director Champion abstained because he arrived after the discussion.
