COMMUNITY EDUCATION

Learning is a life-long activity and the Board of Directors supports community education programs to further this activity. The school district facilities shall be available for community education programs as long as they do not interfere with or disrupt the early childhood special education and kindergarten through grade twelve education programs or other school district activities.

It shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent to develop administrative regulations regarding the use of the school district facilities for community education programs.

Request for use of facilities must follow administrative rules and regulations for the use of school facilities.
