

Board Policy

Code No. 906

PLAYGROUNDS AND SCHOOL GROUNDS

The following regulations shall apply to all playgrounds and school grounds under the control of the Board of Education of the Bettendorf Community School District:

- 1) Motor vehicles, (including motorized recreational vehicles, such as, but not limited to, snowmobiles, minibikes, motorized skateboards, motorbikes, motorcycles and all-terrain vehicles) shall not be operated on school grounds, except roads and parking lots. The prohibition contained in this subsection shall not apply to the police department, public safety vehicles, or the District's maintenance department.
- 2) No person shall fly, operate, use or control any power driven model aircraft except when authorized by the Superintendent of Schools or designee;
- 3) No person shall ride any horse except on the roads and parking lots;
- 4) No person shall carry/shoot any air-gun, paint ball gun, firearm, bow and arrow or other weapon, including incendiary devices, except when authorized by the Superintendent of Schools or designee;
- 5) No person shall change, deface, remove any equipment, building structure, tree, vegetation or machine owned by or under the control of the Board of Education of the Bettendorf Community School District;
- 6) No person shall camp, golf, or trap wild animals unless said activity is authorized by the Superintendent of Schools or designee;
- 7) No person shall throw or deposit on any school grounds or any school district dumpster any glass bottles, glass, nails, tacks, wires, cans, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter, offal or any other debris or any substance likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle;
- 8) All school grounds shall be closed at sunset each day and no person shall resort thereto after sundown unless authorized by the Superintendent of Schools or designee;
- 9) Unless otherwise provided by city ordinances and appropriately posted, the maximum permissible speed of any motor vehicle on school roads and parking lots shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour;
- 10) No person shall operate a hot-air balloon, airplane, glider or hang glider, except when authorized by the Superintendent of Schools or designee, and
- 11) Owners with animals are required to comply with the city's ordinance covering Animals Running At Large when on school grounds.

This policy grants authorization for representatives from the Bettendorf Police Department to have access to school grounds for the purpose of enforcing said regulations.
